
Brother of Oakley Bishop Gored to Death by Bull

OAKLEY, Idaho, Dec. 28.—(AP)
—Richard Adams, 68, was gored to death by a bull while doing the chores in the barnyard on the ranch of his brother, Bishop John Adams here yesterday afternoon.

Investigation of the death which was without witnesses was made by Coroner D. E. Johnson, Burley. The injured man was discovered a few minutes after the attack of the bull by Ross Adams, nephew. Death came before he could be cared for.

The deceased was born in Tooele county, Utah, July 9, 1865, the son of John and Mary Catherine Adams. He was a bachelor and is survived by four brothers and three sisters: John Adams, Oakley; Herbert Adams, Salt Lake City, Mrs. George Craner, Burley; Thomas and Walter Adams, Mrs. Annie Gillespie and Mrs. Agnes Lindholm, Tooele, Utah.

The funeral will be at 1 p.m. Saturday in Oakley.
